

THE LARRY AND LOUISE HUFFMAN SCHOLARSHIP

Objective

The Larry and Louise Huffman Scholarship provides financial assistance to deserving individuals who plan to prepare themselves for teaching and a coaching career. Both Larry and Louise taught in the Burke County Schools. "Coach" Huffman understood and proved over a nearly thirty-year career that an active role model can make a tremendous positive impact in the lives of student athletes. Louise began her career after the age of 40, teaching third grade at Hildebran Elementary School for twenty years. Her dedication to public school education inspired students as well as fellow teachers. In tribute to their legacy and to encourage others to follow his example, this scholarship will be offered yearly to eastern Burke County high school graduates.

Selection Procedure

One or more scholarship(s) will be offered to eastern Burke County high school graduates. Applications will be reviewed by a selection committee, consisting of representatives of the East Burke Kiwanis Club, the Huffman family, East Burke High School and Jimmy C. Draughn High School athletic programs. Each applicant's interest in serving others, academic and athletic achievements, financial need, and evidence of good character will be considered of utmost importance in the selection.

Applicants must have already been accepted by the college/university they plan to attend before scholarship funds will be sent to the college/university

The decisions of the selection committee will be final, and reason(s) for their decisions will not be made public.

Former applicants may reapply and will be in competition with first-time applicants.

Requirements

- Complete the application form.
- Include a copy of your high school transcript and, if applicable, your college/university transcript.
- Enclose a small photograph of yourself.
- Include three letters of recommendations from non-related individuals who know you and your capabilities.

Procedure for Scholarship Payment

A statement from the educational institution must be sent each semester to the Community Foundation of Burke County. The first statement will indicate that the student has enrolled in college. A copy of the scholarship recipient's grades must accompany the second statement. Scholarship recipients must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA and remain in a teaching field of study. If the recipient fails, leaves school, or changes to a non-education field, the scholarship will be terminated.

Payment of scholarship award will be made directly to the college or university at the beginning of the academic year.

Announcement

Winner of the Larry and Louise Huffman Scholarship will be notified at the High School Awards Day and/or by mail.
